Program Description

Founded in 1956, Legal Services of Northern California (LSNC) provides high quality civil legal assistance to people who are low income, elderly and disabled in 23 northern California counties.

Responsibilities

Under the supervision of attorneys, law student externs may: participate in client intake interviews, conduct factual investigation and legal research, draft memos, prepare legal documents, appear at administrative hearings, and provide general legal information to eligible community groups.

Qualifications

- A minimum commitment of ten hours per week during the semester.
- Externs must be able to attend a mandatory virtual orientation on Friday, August 25, 2023.
- Demonstrated interest in and ability to work with low-income individuals and communities, people with disabilities, older people, people with limited English proficiency, and other client communities. Skills: legal research and writing, analytical reasoning, creativity, communication and listening skills, ability to work under short time lines and input data into our online case management system.
