Program Description

Founded in 1956, Legal Services of Northern California (LSNC) provides high quality civil legal assistance to people who are low income, older adults and people with disabilities in 23 northern California counties.

Responsibilities

Under the supervision of attorneys, law student externs may: participate in client intake interviews, conduct factual investigation and legal research, draft memos, prepare legal documents, attend administrative hearings, engage in community outreach, and work on a semester-long project.

Qualifications

- a. For Fall 2026 semester only, applicants must have participated in a **previous** internship, externship, or law student volunteer opportunity with Legal Services of Northern California.
- b. A minimum commitment of twelve (12) hours per week.
- c. Externs must be able to attend a mandatory orientation on **August 21, 2026**.
- d. Demonstrate an interest in and ability to work with low-income individuals and communities, people with disabilities, older people, people with limited English proficiency, and other client communities.
- e. Engage in legal research and writing, analytical reasoning, good communication skills, ability to work under short time lines and input data into an online case management system.
