### **Program Description**

Since 1956, LSNC has provided high quality civil legal assistance to people who are low income, older adults and people with disabilities in 23 northern California counties.

### **Responsibilities**

Under the supervision of attorneys, law student externs may: participate in client intake interviews, conduct factual investigation and legal research, draft memos, prepare legal documents, appear at administrative hearings, and provide general legal information to eligible community groups.

### **Qualifications**

- a. **A minimum commitment of twelve hours per week.**
- b. Externs must be able to attend a **mandatory orientation on August 22, 2025**.
- c. Demonstrated interest in and ability to work with low-income individuals and communities, people with disabilities, older people, people with limited English proficiency, and other client communities.
- d. Strong legal research and writing, analytical reasoning, creativity, communication and listening skills, ability to work under short time lines and input data into an online case management system.
